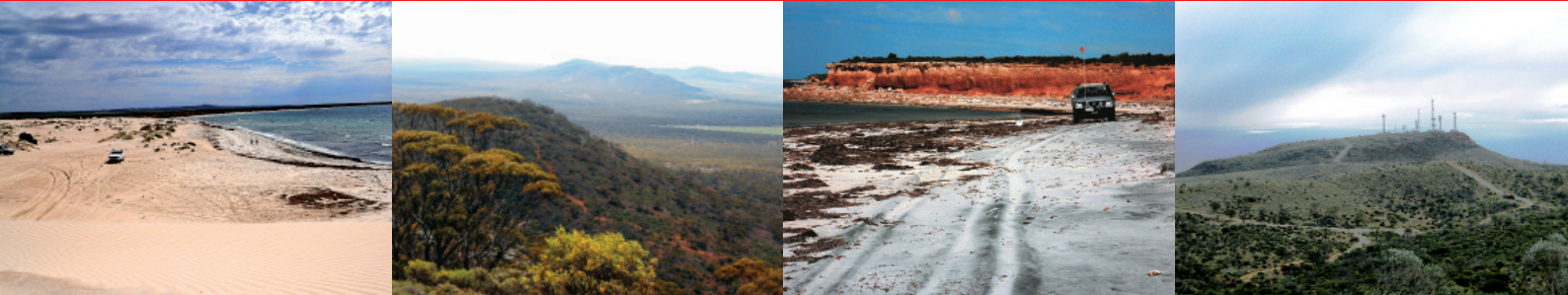

Join us in 2012 at this very unique location – Whyalla and surrounds – where you will be able to experience both outback driving and beach driving.

Owners of local pastoral properties will generously open their tracks to us for our event. They include tracks through the Middleback Range, Sinclairs Gap and Cooks Gap through to the peak for views of Spencer Gulf in one direction and to the salt lakes in the other.

Other possible trips for us to enjoy follow explorer Edward John Eyre's tracks and the Old Telegraph line as well as tracks through Wild Dog Conservation Park. Mt Laura is a 4WD playground right next to the showgrounds providing challenging hill climbs and winding bush tracks.

The region provides great sand driving opportunities along with the Point Gibbon sand dunes for added difficulty.

The Whyalla showgrounds will be the base for our event. It has powered sites, lots of showers and toilets and big sheds. Weather permitting, we may be able to have a camp fire in the evenings.

Whyalla township is easily accessible from the showgrounds with many stores and refuelling stations available. Tourist attractions include a tour of the steelworks, Eco tours of dolphins, pelicans and cuttlefish, snorkelling and diving, the Maritime Museum, Pichi Richi Railway trips, Mt Laura Homestead Museum, craft museums, heritage trips, Point Lowly Lighthouse, walks and trails and mine tours.

Extend your trip and visit the Gawler Ranges National Park and the Argadells, the Flinder's best kept secret not far from Quorn.
